Solo Stove, a DTC grill and fire pit brand, is rumored to be eyeing an IPO. The company, which sells a variety of fire pit and grill products, has changed its name to Solo Brands. It has recently acquired Chubbies, Oru Kayak, and Isle.

Is Solo Stove a Direct-to-Consumer (DTC) brand?

Solo Stove, a Direct-to-Consumer (DTC) brand specializing in grills and fire pits, has changed its name to Solo Brands. It has acquired Chubbies, Oru Kayak, and Isle. Solo Stove, founded in 2011, has focused solely on selling products like fire pits, grills, and camp stoves.

Can solo brands grow beyond its stove product?

Solo Brands (NYSE: DTC) has filed to raise \$200 million in an IPO of its Class A common stock, according to an S-1/A registration statement. The firm acquires and develops consumer products brands in the United States. It is unclear if management is able to grow the company beyond its Solo Stove product.

Where are solo stoves made?

An analysis follows below. Solo Brands, Inc. is located just outside Dallas in Grapevine, TX. This direct-to-consumer outdoor and lifestyle products company offers several key product lines. Its biggest seller is camp stoves under the Solo Stove Lite brand name.

How much does a solo stove cost?

Solo Brands aims to make its stoves at least relatively accessible, offering a wide variety of styles, sizes and price points to entice new consumers to give the brand a shot. Stoves range from a seven-inch-wide tabletop firepit called the Mesa, priced at \$104.99, to the 27-inch-wide Yukon, listed at \$459.99 on the company's website.



Although Solo Stove makes everything from pizza ovens to grills, their star product is a portable, smokeless fire pit.. These stainless steel fire pits give off very little smoke and ash by creating an environment where the fire burns super hot. This creates a secondary burn that eliminates much of the ash and most of the smoke before reaching you.

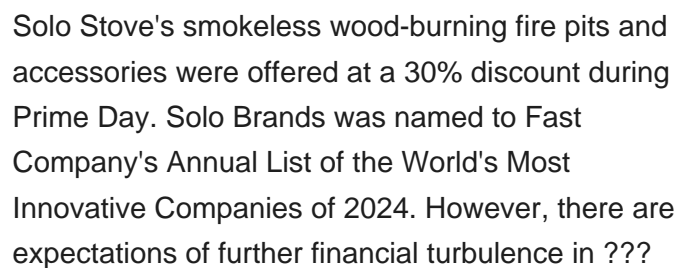
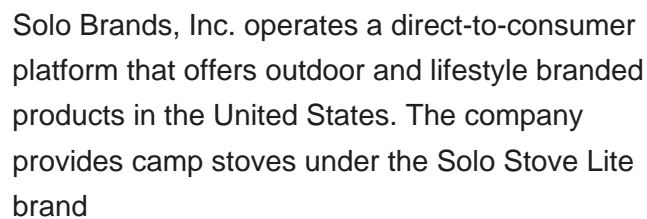
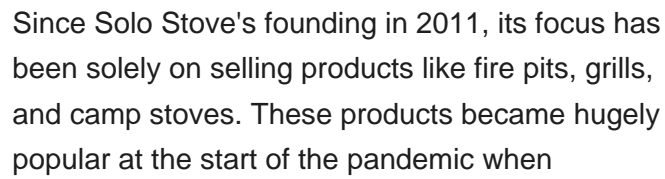
