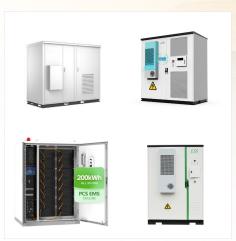

Solar equipment costs. The panels themselves are probably the first thing that comes to mind when you think about going solar, but solar panels represent less than a third of the total solar equipment costs. You can expect all required solar equipment, including supply chain costs and sales tax, to cost \$13,800???about 46% of the total system



To calculate your solar payback period, divide your solar panel system's cost by your yearly electricity bill savings. For example, if you spent \$15,000 and now save \$2,000 a year, your solar system will take 7.5 years to pay for itself.

Price of Solar Panels. Solar panels cost \$0.70 to \$1.50 per watt on average but can run from \$0.30 to \$2.20 per watt. A typical 250 watt panel costs \$175 to \$375 on average. For an entire solar system, the average homeowner pays \$3,910 to \$6,490. Panels can cost as low as \$1,890 and as high as \$13,600.. This price depends on several factors:
