

Why is Somalia implementing a power master plan?

Somalia has produced and is implementing a Power Master Plan which outlines strategies to increase energy production, increase the supply of renewable energy, and for government to establish regulatory authorities and a legislative framework to improve market efficiency.

What is the energy sector like in Somalia?

Energy Sector Strong demand for affordable electricity: The need for cheaper and reliable electricity throughout Somalia is high and growing, as evidenced by the expansion of independent power providers and the establishment of microgrids in a growing number of cities.

How much power does Somalia have?

Current generation capacity is 106 megawatts, largely composed of expensive and pollutant diesel generators, though Somalia has great potential for solar and offshore wind power generation that can support a transition to green energy and reduce GHG emissions.

Could solar power be a key driver of development in Somalia?

Solar power could potentially be one of the main drivers of development for the energy sector in Somalia. The country also has one of the greatest solar potentials in Africa:

- o Overall 3,000 hours of sunlight per year
- o One of the highest rates of sun irradiation: 2000 kWh/M²

Why is electricity so important in Somalia?

Strong demand for affordable electricity: The need for cheaper and reliable electricity throughout Somalia is high and growing, as evidenced by the expansion of independent power providers and the establishment of microgrids in a growing number of cities. As a largely agricultural economy, demand is high in the dairy and fisheries sectors.

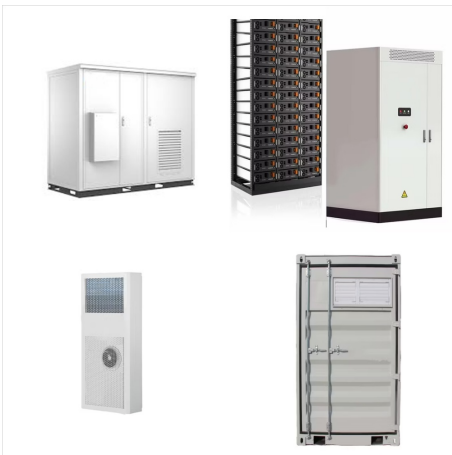

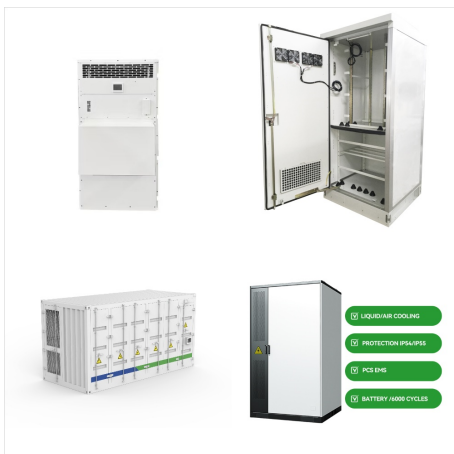
