


How do I fix or bypass the Push Power Protector message on my Sony Home Theatre preventing the use of this receiver and it's sound system MOD # HCD-HDX 501W S# 850 8417. I checked the manual and took the corrective steps suggested but nothing works. Expand Post. Home Theater & SoundBars

This is normal. To reset the internal surge protection circuit unplug the AC power cord from the wall for at least 30 minutes. Ensure the top of the home audio device has proper ventilation to keep it from overheating. Running the home audio device in a poorly ventilated cabinet can trigger the protection circuit. Reduce the volume level.





This is why there is usually a slight delay from the time the unit is turned on to the time you hear sound. In this case, I would suspect that the output transistors/amp pac have failed. The system now boots up and the display, dvd player etc works but no sound from the speakers. I have a Sony BDV e4100 showing push power protection



The PROTECT and PUSH POWER messages will flash alternately when the protective device of the amplifier has been activated because a strong signal was input, or if there is a short-circuit ???

Finally I cleaned the internal boards and reattached all the internal cables which seems to have partially fix the problem.
