

The DMRE has extended the Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) deadline to 7 December 2025. The amended regulations apply to both public and private buildings. The extension allows buildings owners more time to prepare for EPC submission for the required buildings.



An energy performance certificate must also be submitted to the South African National Energy Development Institute. The certificates are valid for five years. The new rules apply to all offices and other private non-residential buildings (schools, malls and theatres etc.) that are bigger than 2,000 square metres.




Section 19(1)(b) of the National Energy Act of 1998 (act no. 34 of 2008) of South Africa requires all public and private buildings with a net floor area of more than 1000 square meters and 2000 square meters respectively to display an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) indicating their energy performance or face penalties.
