


For comparison, Moldova proper can generate up to 100MW in its combined heat-power plants and the small hydropower group. In 30 years, the entire government-controlled area of Moldova has secured production capacity of 100MW when the country's peak consumption is 950MW. That means barely 10% of its energy consumption at critical times.

The energy system of the Republic of Moldova is interconnected with that of Romania through a high-voltage line that connects the Isaccea transformer station in Romania and the Vulcănești transformer station in the Republic of Moldova.




The electricity system in Moldova is characterised by its reliance on imports. In 2020, of its 4.4 TWh of electricity demand, 81% was supplied by imports, either from Ukraine (4%) or from the Cuciurgani-Moldavskaya GRES (MGRES) gas-fired power plant (77%) located in the breakaway region of Transnistria.



Moldova's energy landscape shifted significantly following the conflict in Ukraine in 2022, leading to a swift connection to the European energy system and a move away from reliance on Russian energy supplies. What is Moldova's target for green power by 2030?







The objective goal set in the Moldovan Energy Strategy 2030 to increase the share of renewables in the final energy consumption to 17% in 2020 was overreached (25% in 2020), mainly because of heating (share of 41%), as the share for electricity was only 3% and that for transport 0.2%.
