

Madagascar's energy balance shows that about 80% of its overall energy consumption is based on biomass (mainly firewood 68%, charcoal 10% and other biomass 2%), 17% on petrol (transport), 2% on electricity (hydropower and diesel power plants) and 1% on coal. Madagascar is among Africa's richest countries in terms of renewable energy potential. Many of the island's regions have more than 2800 hours of annual sunshine, which are some of the highest levels on the continent. The north and south of Madagascar have wind speeds that are highly favourable to the production of electricity.



In 2019, Madagascar's energy mix was dominated by biofuels and wastes (85%), with oil products (11%), coal and hydro accounting for the rest of the total energy supply. In 2020, less than 5% of the population had access to clean cooking and 27% had access to electricity. The Government of Madagascar has set a target of reaching 70%
