What will a 210 kilowatt solar system mean for Tokelau?

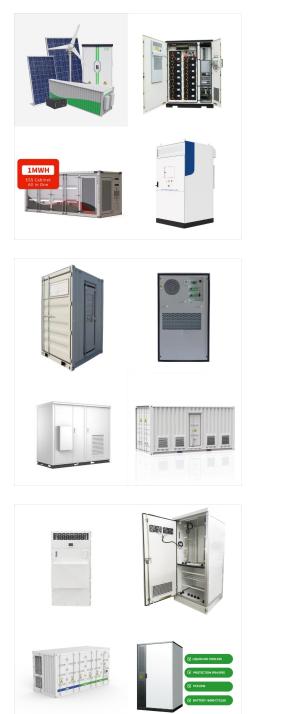
Vector PowerSmart chief operating officer Colin Daly said the project would mean the people of Tokelau would enjoy "clean,reliable and renewable energy" for years to come. Additional 210 kilowatt solar arrays would be installed on Atafu,Fakaofo and Nukunonu,along with two megawatt hour lithium ion battery storage systems.

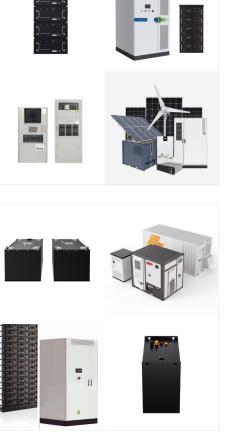

With the help of PowerSmart, around 4,032 solar panels were scattered all over Tokelau Island, exceeding residents" power demand up to 150 percent. The project itself started with proposals

The project includes : 4032 solar modules, 196 string inverters, 112 DC charge controllers, 84 battery inverters and 1344 batteries in 48V banks. The system allows for up to 2 days of energy without any solar input.

Initially the solar system will supply a mini-grid consisting of several households, but in the medium term it will be fully integrated with the existing diesel supplied power grid in ???

A week ago New Zealand solar systems installer PowerSmart said it had wrapped up 1 MW of solar installations that can meet 150% of the current electricity needs of Tokelau. The islands, administered by New Zealand, have a population of about 1,500 people.





Tokelau's three main atolls now have enough solar capacity, on average, to meet electricity needs," Mr McCully says.
