Should the South Georgia & South Sandwich Islands have a no-take marine area?

Scientists and governments are calling for large no-take marine areas,free from industrial exploitation. The South Georgia and South Sandwich Islands Marine Protected Area is undergoing its second five-yearly review. Recovery of baleen whales coupled with climate change,means managers must be alert to alternative future ecosystem states.

What is the ccTLD for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The MPA, approximately 1.07 x 10 6 km 2, included a number of strict no-take (IUCN Category 1a) zones located within 12 nautical miles of South Georgia, Clerke Rocks, Shag Rocks and Black Rock, and within 3 nautical miles of each of the South Sandwich Islands, giving a total area of 20,431 km 2 that provided refugia for fish species (including





South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands are a collection of exceptionally remote islands in the Southern Atlantic. Although considered as one entity they represent two physically distinct island groups, with the South Georgia cluster ranging between 560 and 800km west of the South Sandwich Island arc (Figure 1).


