The EBRD has already earmarked 300 million euros to support Ukraine's energy sector in coming months, and expects to deploy the funds soon, Arvid Tuerkner, the EBRD's Managing Director for Ukraine and Moldova, said in an interview on Wednesday.

How much money has urc24 contributed to Ukraine's energy sector?

The Group has so far been able to mobilize more than USD 5 billion in support of Ukraine's energy sector, including more than USD 1 billioncommitted since URC24 in June as a reaction to the intensified Russian attacks.






