



Is Uranus a big planet?

Uranus, seventh planet in distance from the Sun and the least massive of the solar system's four giant, or Jovian, planets, which also include Jupiter, Saturn, and Neptune. At its brightest, Uranus is just visible to the unaided eye as a blue-green point of light. It is designated by the symbol ♅ .

Where did Uranus come from?

Like its neighbor Neptune, Uranus likely formed closer to the Sun and moved to the outer solar system about 4 billion years ago, where it is the seventh planet from the Sun. Uranus is one of two ice giants in the outer solar system (the other is Neptune).

Why is it called Uranus?

Instead, the planet was named for Uranus, the Greek god of the sky, as suggested by Johann Bode. Uranus' environment is not conducive to life as we know it. The temperatures, pressures, and materials that characterize this planet are most likely too extreme and volatile for organisms to adapt to.

What is Uranus made of?

The planet is made of ice, gases and liquid metal. Its atmosphere contains hydrogen, helium and methane. The temperature on Uranus is $-197\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$ ($-322.6\text{ }^{\circ}\text{F}$; 76.1 K) near the top of its atmosphere. Its small solid core (about 55% the mass of Earth) is probably about $4,730\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$ ($8,540\text{ }^{\circ}\text{F}$; $5,000\text{ K}$).

When was Uranus discovered?

William Herschel first observed Uranus on 13 March 1781, leading to its discovery as a planet, expanding the known boundaries of the Solar System for the first time in history and making Uranus the first planet classified as such with the aid of a telescope.

Is Uranus the same as Neptune?

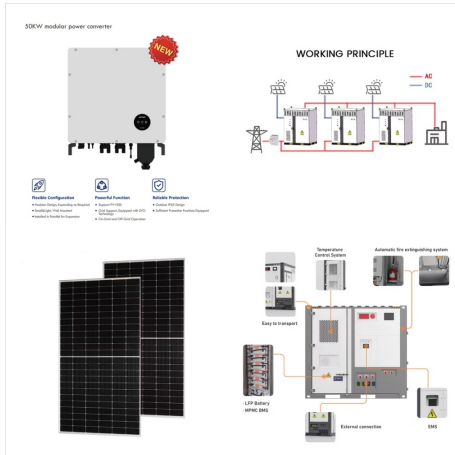

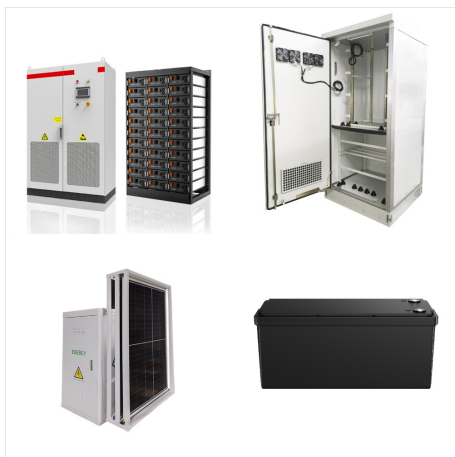

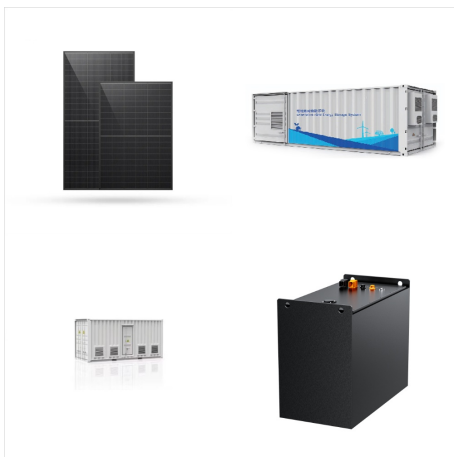

The composition of the Uranian atmosphere is different from that of Uranus as a whole, consisting mainly of molecular hydrogen and helium. 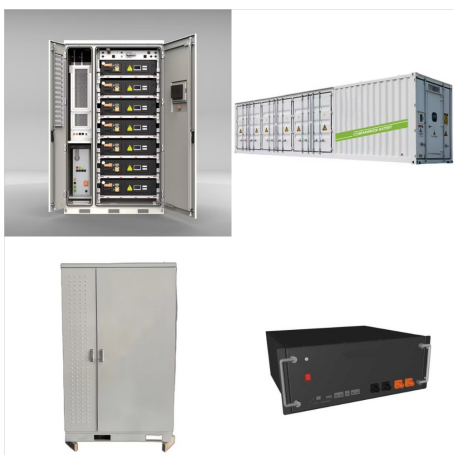
