

These batteries need to be shipped separately from other types. It is especially dangerous to ship them with Lithium batteries of any kind. During the recycling process for lead-acid batteries, they are crushed. When lithium batteries are crushed in the same container, they explode. Lithium batteries need to be recycled and cannot go into the

While most standard household batteries can be disposed with household trash, the department recommends taking them to a permanent household hazardous waste collection facility for recycling or disposal.



Implementation Timeline. On and after January 1, 2026, Consumers will be required to pay a covered battery-embedded waste recycling fee. This fee will apply when purchasing a new or refurbished CBEP. On or before August 1, 2027, CalRecycle and DTSC will review the covered battery-embedded waste recycling fee for CBEPs. Upon review, we will make fair and ???





Find a drop-off location at a store near you; Visit a Special Waste Drop-off site; Bring them to a SAFE Disposal event; DO NOT put rechargeable or lithium-ion batteries in the trash or recycling. These batteries are commonly used in cell phones, laptops, digital cameras, rechargeable household appliances and power tools, and electric bikes
