In a letter to the church, the Pope said the project will be developed on Vatican-owned property outside of Rome that spans 424 hectares, adding further capacity to existing solar ???

Once built, the solar plant will extend its supply power from the Vatican radio station to the entire 825 people living in the city. The city only produced about 0.0000443% output of carbon emission in 2022 but the Pope is eager to transition successfully to encourage the development of sustainable models in other countries.



The system consists of 2,400 solar panels that have been designed by a Germany-based company. The panels will collectively generate about 300 MWh of clean energy annually, which will not only be sufficient for all the electricity needs of the building on which the system has been mounted, but will also provide electricity for several surrounding buildings.

An agrivoltaic solar plant will be constructed at the Santa Maria di Galeria, a 424-hectare property on the edge of Rome that is owned by the Vatican and is now used for the transmission facilities for Vatican Radio. The solar power produced on the site will be used for Vatican Radio and will contribute to the energy needs of Vatican City.



Name. The name Vatican City was first used in the Lateran Treaty, signed on 11 February 1929, which established the modern city-state named after Vatican Hill, the geographic location of the state within the city of Rome. "Vatican" itself is derived from the name of an Etruscan settlement, Vatica or Vaticum, located in the general area the Romans called Ager Vaticanus, "Vatican???
