What is a superhabitable planet?

A superhabitable planet is a world that might have an even better chance at hosting life than our own home, Earth. Because Earth is the only known inhabited planet and its life depends on liquid water, efforts to identify exoplanets that could host life focus on Earth-like worlds.

Is there a 9th planet?

In 2016,researchers proposed the possible existence of a ninth planet,for now,dubbed "Planet Nine" or Planet X. The planet is estimated to be about 10 times the mass of Earth and to orbit the sun between 300 and 1,000 times farther than the orbit of the Earth. Scientists have not seen Planet Nine.

Which planet is closest to the Sun?

Mercuryis the closest planet to the sun and also the smallest planet in the solar system. The small and cratered planet does not have any moons and zips around the sun faster than any other planet in the solar system,hence why the Romans named it after their swift-footed messenger god.
