Can you recycle a car battery?

Car batteries, rechargeable batteries (including AA,9-volt, the one in the back of your cell phone, and the like), and even button cell watch batteries contain heavy metals and other toxic chemicals. Recycling batteries like these is often required by law.

How do you use a battery recycling container?

It's easy to use--simply fill it with batteries and ship it to a recycling facility--and a pre-addressed shipping label, home pickup, and recycling fees are included in the cost of the container.

Do you have to pay for recycling a battery?

You may have to pay for recycling. These batteries are typically found in watches or hearing aids. Manufacturers may offer take-back recycling programs. Single-use batteries do not contain heavy metals, which limits their recycling market. You may have to pay for recycling.

Can rechargeable batteries be recycled?

Rechargeable batteries can be recycled. Look for the battery recycling seals on rechargeable batteries. Recycling companies dispose of the components of rechargeable batteries properly. The metals and chemicals don't end up in streams and landfills. The Home Depot has partnered with Call2Recycle, a nonprofit battery recycling program.

Can I recycle a battery if I'm leaving them outside?

Many local authorities recommend calling ahead of any pickups to ensure that they accept the battery type you're hoping to recycle. If you're hoping to use a collection service, check the current schedule on the local authority website before leaving batteries outside.

## WHERE DO I TAKE BATTERIES TO BE RECYCLED

More recently, VW UK announced that in February 2024, they would partner with a company called Ecobat to collect and recycle EV batteries at the new recycling facility in the UK. Within this facility the core elements of the recycled batteries are recovered and then refined, with over 80 per cent of the material returned to battery manufacturing.

Batteries are recycled in a multistep metallurgical process. Batteries are shredded and sorted into requisite components. There are many metals, plastics, and secondary materials that are recovered including zinc and iron.


