Where can I recycle a car battery?

For small primary batteries, simply locate a local battery recycling centernear you. For rechargeable batteries, like the ones used cell phones, remote controls, and cameras, most retailers that sell them are required to accept and recycle them. As for batteries that are used for cars or golf carts, they are simply banned from landfills.

Where can I recycle a single-use battery?

Check with your local municipality, waste hauler, and local solid waste district to see if they collect single-use batteries for recycling or if they accept batteries during household hazardous waste collection days. Some local hardware storeswill also accept single-use batteries for recycling, but it is not always free.

Where can I recycle HHW batteries?

Check your city website or use Earth911 recycling search to find a HHW location near you. How are batteries recycled? Depending on which kind of battery you are recycling, battery components can become many different new products.

Can you recycle a rechargeable battery?

These batteries are typically found in watches or hearing aids. Manufacturers may offer take-back recycling programs. Single-use batteries do not contain heavy metals, which limits their recycling market. You may have to pay for recycling. Rechargeable batteries are used in everything from portable electronics to hybrid cars.

How much does it cost to recycle a battery?

The WeRecycle Battery Box, which range in price from \$44.95 to \$115.95, is another solution for recycling a large amount of batteries. Call2Recycle, a nonprofit that leads rechargeable battery recycling programs





Non-leaking batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store. Place your batteries in the plastic bags provided and drop them in the bin. There is no charge for recycling. The Impact of Recycling. In 2022, The Home Depot recycled 180,000 lead-acid batteries. The same year, we recycled 1,300,000 pounds of rechargeable batteries.

Important Notes on Recycling or Disposing of Batteries: When preparing batteries for recycling or disposal, always cover the electrical connections or battery terminals with a non-conductive tape (electrical or vinyl) or seal individual batteries in separate plastic bags so they cannot conduct electricity. This helps eliminate potential fire or
