

Why is affordable electricity important in Somalia?

"Access to affordable electricity is critical for reducing poverty, as it helps increase household income, improve the business climate, and create jobs," said Kristina Svensson, World Bank Country Manager for Somalia.

Does Somalia have access to electricity?

"Access to energy is a precondition to development, supporting livelihoods and powering essential services such as education and healthcare," said UNDP Resident Representative in Somalia Jocelyn Mason. "However, 65% of people don't have access to electricity in Somalia."

How much power does Somalia have?

Indeed, the UN alone has approximately 65 megawatts (MW) of generator capacity, while Somalia's official energy figures show only 125 MW of total installed electricity generation capacity in the entire country.

What are the energy practices of the UN in Somalia?

While the specific institutional arrangements are unique to Somalia, the energy practices of the UN are similar to those in other international peace operations in fragile contexts; they are overwhelmingly dependent on diesel generators for power, and represent sizable energy footprints in the areas where they are deployed.

How can Somalia benefit from regional integration?

The Federal Government of Somalia (FGS), as an active member of the Horn of Africa Initiative (HoAI), can also leverage the opportunities offered by regional integration to leapfrog the establishment of backbone transmission infrastructure and have access to diverse and low-cost electricity supply from regional neighbors.
