

What is solar\*rewards for residences?

Produce your own solar energy, and sell us what you don't use. Through our Solar\*Rewards for Residences program, you install solar panels at your home so that you can produce your own energy. If you produce more than you need, the extra energy is added to our grid, and you receive a credit on your bill.

What benefits does solar\*rewards offer?

Additionally, all Solar\*Rewards customers receive net energy metering benefits. When the system produces more solar energy than is needed, the extra energy is added to our grid and you may receive a credit on your monthly billing statement.

How do Xcel Energy incentives work?

The up-front incentives are available for income-qualified products only and are calculated based on the proposed system size (kilowatts direct current). In most cases, the solar developer or installer will submit an application on your behalf and manage the details of your project directly with Xcel Energy, or you can manage your own application.

What is solar rewards community?

Participate in renewable offerings and support the development of nearby solar gardens without the hassle of installing solar panels on your home or business. Solar\*Rewards Community is the nation's largest community solar program and gives you the opportunity to subscribe to a nearby, third-party community solar garden.

What happens if I subscribe to Xcel Energy?

Once subscribed, customers will begin receiving credits on their monthly utility bill for the solar energy that their subscription contributes to the Xcel Energy grid. Curious about how this fits into your sustainability goals?

Do Xcel Energy customers qualify for net metering benefits?

In addition to receiving Net Metering benefits, customers who qualify under the terms of Income Qualified or Disproportionately Impacted Communities can receive an upfront rebate of \$1 per watt of installed solar up to 10kW AC. Must be an Xcel Energy residential or business electricity customer.

What Is Solar\*Rewards? Solar\*Rewards is a 10-year incentive program for qualifying utility customers with Xcel Energy in Minnesota. When your solar array produces a certain amount of electricity, you earn something called a Renewable Energy Credit (REC). By enrolling in Solar\*Rewards, you give your RECs to Xcel Energy in exchange for cash
