

As of 31 July 2019, the Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (ZERA) had issued more than 77 power generation licences with 42being solar power projects. A number of IPPs are already selling electricity to the Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission and Distribution Company (ZETDC) and feeding into the national grid.

What is the energy sector in Zimbabwe?

The energy sector in Zimbabwe is supervised by the Ministry of Energy and Power Development (MEPD).

The Ministry's mandate includes policy formulation, performance monitoring and regulation of the energy sector, as well as research and promotion of new and renewable sources of energy and energy conservation.

Could solar power be cheaper in Zimbabwe?

Zimbabwe has enough solar power to support these. These solar systems could be made cheaperthrough the introduction of subsidies and tax incentives. Even better, the government could waive taxes on all certified systems coming into the country. And more needs to be done to publicise the use of gas in urban and rural households.

How many MW of solar energy has Zimbabwe deployed in 2022?

Will Zimbabwe produce 1575 MW of solar power by 2030?

The Zimbabwean government aims to produce 1575 MW of power from solarby 2030, which is the same amount that Zimbabwe is producing currently. The government has also rolled out innovation mechanisms such as net metering and feed-in tariff for clean energy to enable Independent Power Producers to add their



excess electricity to the national grid.
